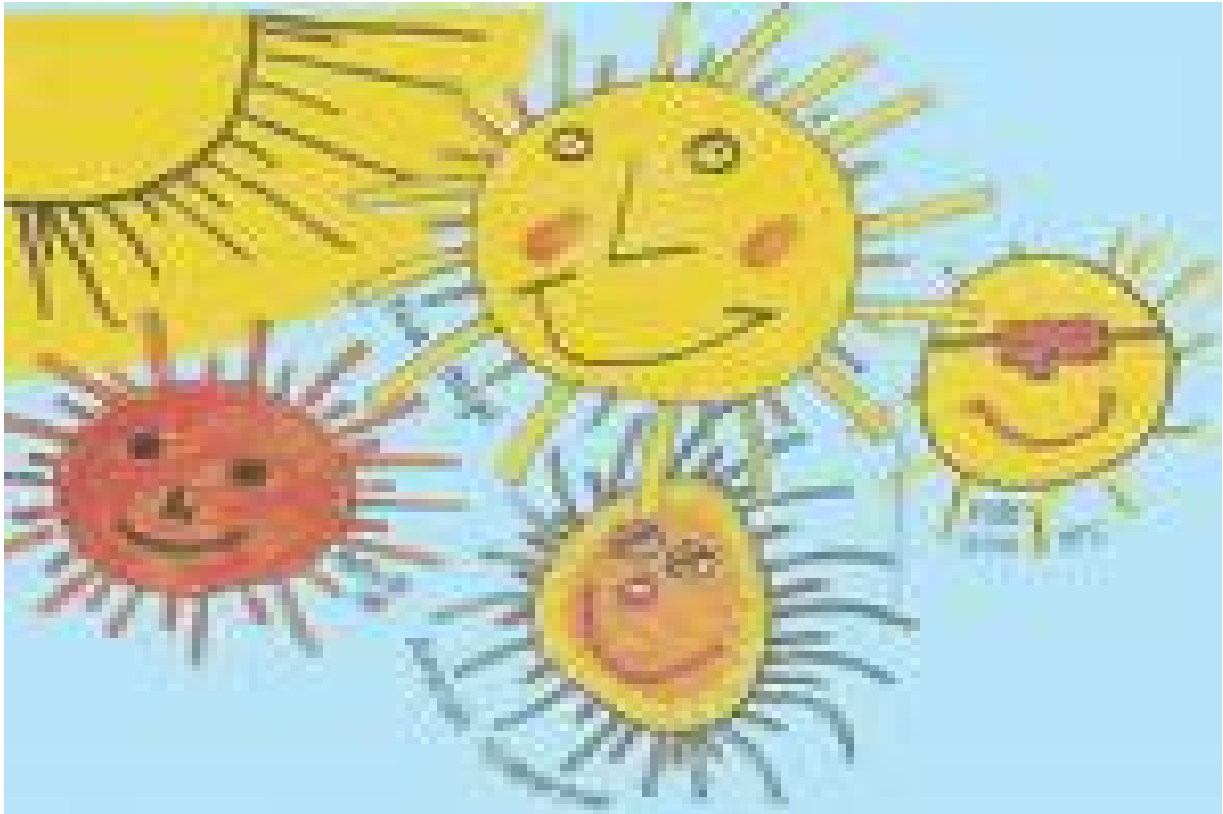

The Parents Advice Centre is offering practitioners who work directly and indirectly with parents, workshops which are designed to develop your skills as a practitioner and also to give you the tools to enhance your professional and personal development. Workshops to be held in our Belfast and Derry offices.

Managing Children's Challenging Behaviour

This is a quick overview of the many practical ways of understanding children's challenging and difficult behaviour. Practitioners will be given practical tips and advice that they will be able to pass onto parents.

Effective Communication Within Your Setting

This workshop will give you practical tips on how to communicate confidently and concisely with both parents, children and co-workers. Practitioners will have an opportunity to share good practice and common difficulties faced within your work setting.

Sink or Swim

This workshop is suitable for practitioners working with parents who have mild to moderate levels of depression. Practitioners will be better equipped to support parents in addressing issues including communication, managing emotions, self-esteem and support systems. The programme adopts a relaxed and interactive approach.

Parenting in a Diverse Society

The workshop focuses on how parents can promote their children's tolerance and understanding in today's culturally diverse society. The programme looks at the differing cultural attitudes and some of the legislation, giving practitioners a better understanding of how best to support families within their own community.

Stepping Up

This workshop deals with specific issues that living in a stepfamily can present. The programme aims to encourage communication and strengthen relationships where there has not been biological bonding. Practitioners will have a better understanding of the challenges that step parenting presents.
